SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under the authority granted by Decision No. 26098 dated June 26, 1933, the Pacific Gas and Electric Company conditionally conveyed its Gold Hill Water System in Placer County to Nevada Irrigation District. One of the conditions under which the property was conveyed requires the district, until it has fully paid for the properties, at its own cost and expense, to repair, maintain and keep in condition for operation to their respective capacities all of the canals of the Gold Hill Water System, unless the Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall hereafter in writing authorize the district to reduce the capacity or partially or wholly abandon any of said canals.

It appears from the supplemental application filed on April 23, 1934 that the district and the company, if permitted by the Commission, will abandon all of the Auburn Ravine Canal, except the intake and the first one hundred and fifty lineal feet thereof.

In lieu of said canal the district will construct, maintain and use a new and larger canal at a higher elevation suitably located to meet all requirements of said Auburn Ravine Canal, including the transmission of water to supply the Gold Hill Canal.

Applicants ask permission to execute an agreement (Exhibit A of Exhibit No. 1) covering the abandonment of said Auburn Ravine Canal and the construction of a new canal in lieu thereof.

The Commission has considered such agreement and applicants' request and is of the opinion that this is not a matter on which a hearing is necessary and that applicants' request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicants, Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Nevada Irrigation District, be, and they are hereby, authorized to execute and consummate an agreement in the same form as the agreement filed in this proceeding on April 23, 1934 as Exhibit A of Exhibit No. 1.
