Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Gold Hill Dredging Company, a corporation engaged in mining operations in Placer County, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a written agreement substantially in accordance with the words and figures as written in the form therefor marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein and entered into by and between the above mentioned parties, said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to said Gold Hill Dredging Company, a corporation, on an accommodation basis when same is available and shall be required for mining purposes, of surplus water in Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Boardman Canal in the vicinity of Sections 20 and 21, Township 11 North, Range 7 East, M.D.B. & M., Placer County, California, same not to exceed two hundred (200) miner's inches,¹ at a rate of sixteen cents (16¢) per miner's inch day, and it ap-

1. For the purpose of this agreement a miner's inch shall mean 1.5 cubic feet of water per minute.

pearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Gold Hill Dredging Company, a corporation, be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of surplus water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
