O R D E R

J. P. Thomas, owner of the J. P. Thomas Telephone Company herein requests the Railroad Commission for authority to discontinue the Kenny telephone exchange.

In the application it is shown that the Kenny Exchange has not been in actual operation since 1922, and that there is no demand or need for an exchange or telephone at Kenny.

It appears that a public hearing in this matter is not required and that the request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. P. Thomas be and he is hereby granted authority to discontinue the Kenny telephone exchange on or before June 1, 1934, provided he submits to the Railroad Commission for filing the necessary revised map of his operating territory, rate schedules and rules and regulations governing his telephone service, on or before the fifteenth day immediately preceding the effective date of the discontinuance of the Kenny Ex-

change.
