OPINION

Coast Truck Line, a corporation, requests authority to discontinue passenger service between Hemet, Idyllwild and Keen Camp. This service was acquired by Decision No.26138, dated July 10, 1933, on Application No.18977, from Motor Service Express, a corporation, which had acquired the right, together with the right of property transportation, without consideration, from Motor Transit Company in 1931. When Motor Transit Company transferred its rights it had an application pending to abandon all service because of lack of patronage, and the transfer was approved to preserve public service to the points.

Applicant now alleges that during the year 1933 only fifty five (55) passengers were transported, producing a revenue of \$73.48. It is further alleged that travel between termini is now almost wholly by private automobile because of the im proved roads. Applicant does not intend to abandon its freight service.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Coast Truck Line, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue all passenger service between Hemet, Idyllwild and Keen Camp, as authorized by Decision No.26138, on Application No.18977, provided, applicant shall post notice of such discontinuance at its station at Hemet at least five (5) days before the effective date of such discontinuance; and shall file withdrawal and cancellation of its rates and time schedules therefor within fifteen (15) days after the effective date hereof, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all right for such passenger service, as granted by said Decision No.26138, or otherwise, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, provided, nothing herein shall alter in any manner the right and duty of applicant to transport property.
