BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission is asked in this application to make its order authorizing Public Utilities California Corporation to file correct rates for telegraph service between Lookout and other points in the territory served by the Corporation. A recent check of the filed telegraph rates between Lookout and other points having disclosed a number of irregularities, the Corporation now desires to correct such irregularities and to establish rates for telegraph service between the points referred to on the basis of other telegraph rates of its system.

The change will result in seven (7) decreases and fourteen (14) increases, as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. As it is of record that during 1933 one telegram only was sent between Lookout and other points involved in this proceeding, the change should have no appreciable effect upon the revenues of the Corporation.

The Commission has considered the request of applicant and is of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public

hearing is required and that the application should be granted,
therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Public Utilities California
Corporation shall:

- (1) Change its rates for telegraph service between
Lookout and certain points as shown in the
column titled "Proposed Initial Rate" in Ex-
hibit "A" attached hereto, effective for serv-
ice on and after August 1, 1934.
- (2) Submit to the Railroad Commission for filing,
in accordance with General Order No. 68, the
telegraph rates referred to in (1) above on or
before July 15, 1934.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order
shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
