OPINION and ORDER

J. E. Jones, operating an automotive stage service for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Upper Lake and Lucerne, and intermediate points, Lake county, requests authority to discontinue all service and for the revocation of the rights heretofore granted him. Applicant states that he has lost the contract for transporting United States mail over the route and that the revenue from other sources is insufficient to maintain the service without loss.

This is a matter in which a public hearing appears unnecessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. E. Jones be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all operations authorized by Decision No. 26151, dated July 17, 1933, on Application No. 18931, between Upper Lake and Lucerne, and intermediate points, from and after June 30, 1934, providing applicant shall post notice of such discontinuance at his terminals at least five (5) days before said date and shall, within ten (10) days after such discontinuance file with this Commission withdrawal and cancellation of his tariffs and time schedules therefor.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all rights granted by Decision No. 26151, on Application No. 18931, be and the same hereby are revoked and annulled.
