## OPINION AND ORDER

In this application the Railroad Commission is asked to make an order authorizing the transfer of the properties and business of Hill Warehouse Company to Western Van and Storage Company.

Caldera, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of Hill Warch ouse Company, have been engaged in operating a public warehouse in leased premises located at 1808 - 22nd Street,

Sacramento. It is reported that recently J. S. Caldera agreed to dispose of his interest in the business and properties to J. W. Hill for the sum of \$107.50 and that J. W. Hill in turn agreed to transfer the entire business, properties and equipment to A. E. Travis for the sum of \$215.00. The properties and equipment include one automobile, warehouse scales, hand trucks and other furniture and fixtures as set forth in the application.

A. E. Travis, doing business under the firm name and style of Western Van and Storage Company, is also engaged in the public utility warehouse business, operating at 215 - 12th Street, Sacramento. It is alleged in the application that the proposed transfer to him is in the public interest for the reason that he

has more equipment and better facilities to handle goods offered for warehousing.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, (1) that J. S. Caldera be, and he hereby is, authorized to transfer his interest in the business and properties of Hill Warehouse Company to J. W. Hill, and (2) that J. W. Hill be, and he hereby is, authorized to transfer the business and properties of Hill Warehouse Company, referred to and described in this application, to A. E. Travis and/or Western Van and Storage Company, such transfer to be in accordance with the terms of the agreement attached to said application, provided that J. W. Hill withdraw the tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of Hill Warehouse Company and A. E. Travis adopt such tariffs and all effective supplements thereto.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that A. E. Travis may, if he so desires, conduct his operations under the name of Hill Warth ouse Company.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
