BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER GRANTING SUSPENSION

Humboldt Motor Stages, Inc. requests authority to suspend its passenger, baggage and express between Orick and Weitchpec, a part of its operation between Orick and Orleans. During the first four months of 1934 applicant's revenue from such service was \$5.65 for passengers and \$1.50 from express. The operation was sustained financially by revenue for transporting United States mail which, on July 1 will be carried by another route. The service between Weitchpec and Orleans and Happy Camp will be maintained by the line from Eureka.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Humboldt Motor Stages, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to suspend, on and after June 30, 1934, all operations for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Orick and Weitchpec until such time as traffic conditions justify its restoration or until

further order of this Commission, provided applicant shall within ten (10) days after such discontinuance file notice of suspension of his tariffs and time tables with the Commission.
