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O P I N I O N

Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd. has made application to alter its route, schedule and tariff of its Tour No.15, designated as "California Tour De Luxe," as authorized by Decision No.26569, dated November 25, 1933, on Application No.19181. The alterations sought appear in public interest in that they will provide at reduced time of the trip and reduced fares, trips at the option of tourists over the more important points of interest served by applicant's sightseeing service. Diversions of the trip between Los Angeles and San Francisco and Yosemite are established for tourists who have not the time for the 7-day trip. No need appears for a public hearing and the application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd. be and it is hereby authorized to establish the following optional modifications and alterations in its Tour No.15, designated as "California Tour De Luxe" as follows:

- (a) By offering, in addition to its present schedule for Tour No.15 schedules under which, at the option of the passengers - where five (5) or more passengers desire such service, the return to Los Angeles on the evenings of the second, third, fifth and sixth days, respectively.
- (b) By diverting its schedules on said tour by routing passengers between Monterey and Merced, via Pacheco Pass instead of San Francisco, when five (5) or more passengers make such routing their option.

(c) By using, as a route alternate to the routing via Santa Cruz, the route between Salinas and San Francisco, via San Jose and Palo Alto and over and along the State highway.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall, within ten (10) days after date hereof, file with this Commission its revised time schedules covering the modifications and alterations of service herein authorized and, also, its tariff amendment as set forth in paragraph VII of the application as the rates covering all services on said Route No.15.
