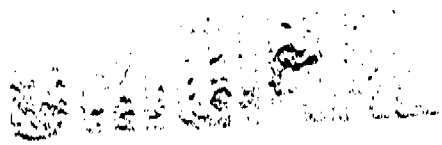


Decision No. 27166.



BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of the SIERRA RAILWAY COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA (Chas. H. Segerstrom, Receiver), to abandon certain stations on its lines in Tuolumne County, State of California.

The Sierra Railway Company of California (Chas. H. Segerstrom, Receiver), on May 2, 1934, applied for authority to abandon, and eliminate all rates to and from, the following stations in Tuolumne County, California:

Harvard Mine,	39.09 miles east of Oakdale (Main Line)
Granite Spur,	47.31 " " " " " "
Draper,	52.72 " " " " " "
Omega Siding,	42.02 " " " " (Angels Branch)
Dutch Mine Spur,	32.09 " " " " (Main Line)

Applicant further requests authority to cancel switching charges as shown in Items 335 and 340 of Local and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 22 (C.R.C. 123).

Applicant alleges that the abandonment of said stations will not affect any shippers or receivers of freight; that there have been no movements to or from said stations for the past twelve (12) months and that no industries will be affected by the cancellation of said Items 335 and 340.
