Decision No. 27179

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of WESTERN CANAL COMPANY a corporation, and RICHVALE IRRIGATION DISTRICT, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California authorizing applicants to enter into a written agreement in words and figures as written in the form therefor which is annexed hereto.

ORDER

Western Canal Company, a corporation, and Richvale
Irrigation District having filed an application with the Railroad
Commission requesting approval of a written agreement substantially in accordance with the words and figures as written in the
form therefor merked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application
herein and entered into by and between the above mentioned parties,
said agreement to be effective for the period commencing July 1,
1934, and ending October 31, 1934, and providing, among other
things, for the sale and delivery to said Richvale Irrigation
District, on an accommodation basis, when and if available at said
Western Canal Company's headdam in the Feather River located in
Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 3 East, M.D.B. & M. to meet
any deficiency in said Irrigation District's water supply which
may occur this coming summer of 1934, of surplus water not exceeding a flow of one hundred (100) cubic feet of water per second as

required by said Irrigation District to make up the then deficiency in its own water supply, said water to be furnished at the rate of seventy-five cents (75¢) per acre foot, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western Canal Company, a corporation, and Richvale Irrigation District be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of surplus water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Western Canal Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
