Decision No. 27180

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, and EL DORADO IRRIGATION DISTRICT, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California authorizing applicants to enter into a written agreement in words and figures as written in the form therefor which is annexed hereto.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and El Dorado Irrigation District having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a written agreement substantially in accordance with the words and figures as written in the form therefor marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein and entered into by and between the above mentioned parties, said agreement to be effective only for the period commencing at noon-time May 15 and ending at noon-time of October 15, 1934, and providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to said El Dorado Irrigation District, on an accommodation basis to meet an anticipated emergency in respect to said Irrigation District's water supply, when and if available, of surplus water from said Pacific Gas and Electric Company's El Dorado Canal not exceeding a flow of ten (10) second feet, said ten (10) second feet to be in excess of the forty (40) second feet to which said

Irrigation District is entitled under a certain "existing contract," dated May 31, 1919, and to be paid for at the rate of twenty cents (20¢) per miner's inch day, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and El Dorado Irrigation District be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of surplus water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
