OPINION and ORDER

Henrietta P. Conner, operating automotive service between Lewiston and Minersville for the transportation of persons and property, has requested authority to discontinue all service and for the revocation of her certificate therefor. Applicant has lost the contract to transport United States mail which in 1933 produced \$2280.00 revenue. The revenue from passengers and freight combined aggregated only \$141.54 during the year. A public hearing appears unnecessary and the application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Henrietta P. Conner be and she is hereby authorized to discontinue all service between Lewiston and Minersville for the transportation of persons and property, provided applicant shall, within ten (10) days from date hereof file with this Commission withdrawal and cancellation of tariffs and time tables on file for such service; and

IT IS HERBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 17708, dated December 3, 1926, on Application No. 13339, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
