REFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to (a) abandon the non-agency station of Lynn, in the County of Kings, State of California, and (b) to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 283 feet in length located at said station.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on July

6, 1934, applied for authority (a) to abandon its non-agency station of Lynn, located on the Riverdale Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kings County and (b) to abandon and remove a spur track approximately two hundred and eighty three feet in length at said station, and shown in yellow on a blue print map (San Joaquin Division Drawing A-4427) attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that no passenger or freight business was transacted during the past twenty-seven months at said station, that said spur track has not been used for more than two years, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on July 12, 1934, signified, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized (a) to abandon its non-agency station of Lynn, located on the Riverdale Branch of its San Joaquin Division, in Kings County, State of California, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station, and (b) to abandon and remove a spur track approximately two hundred and eighty three (283) feet in length at said station of Lynn, subject, however, to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one
 (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
