OPINION and ORDER

T. J. Cronin, operating automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Madera and Wawona, via Raymond, has requested authority to discontinue all service.

Applicant alleges that the revenues are insufficient to support the operation since applicant's contract to carry United States mail expired on June 30, 1934.

The annual report of applicant for 1933 shows operating revenues of \$5124.00 and expense of \$5504., resulting in a loss of \$380.00. The mail revenue for this period was \$3520, leaving a gross from public utility business of \$1604.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is unnecessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all service for the transportation of passengers and/or property between Madera and Wawona, via Raymond, and intermediate points, provided, applicant shall file, in triplicate, and make effective within a period of not to exceed twenty (20) days from the effective date of this order, on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and the public, cancellation of tariffs and time schedules on

file for such service; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No.13159, dated February 15, 1924, on Application No.9396, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
