OPINION and ORDER

James A. Ross, operating automotive transportation service for passengers and for property between Fortuna and Bridgeville and intermediate points, has made application to discontinue all service and for the revocation of his operative rights.

Applicant has lost his mail contract over the route. Exhibit "A" attached to the application shows that his gross revenue for the first six months of 1934 was \$1159, of which \$1092 was for transportation of mail. His public transportation revenue \$67.00, obviously not a patronage justifying continuation of service.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that James A. Ross be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all service for the transportation of persons and for property between Fortuna and Bridgeville and intermediate points, provided applicant shall file, in triplicate, and make effective within a period of not to exceed twenty (20) days from the effective date of this Order, on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and the public, cancellation of tariffs and time schedules on file for such service.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 23292, dated January 19, 1931, on Application No. 17103 be and that the same hereby is revoked and annulled.

This Order shall become effective on the date of signature thereof.
