BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND ORDER

F. M. Littlefield, operating automotive service for the transportation of passengers and/or property between Monterey and Big Sur and intermediate points, has requested authority to discontinue all service and for the revocation of his operating rights. Applicant has lost the mail contract over the route he serves and alleges that the income from public utility operations is insufficient to justify continuation. Applicant's annual report to this Commission for 1933 shows gross receipts of \$1,930.87, of which \$1,650.00 was from transporting mail and \$280.87 from passengers (17) and property (12.5 tons). Apparently such revenue will not sustain an operation of 75 miles daily.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that F. M. Littlefield be, and he hereby is, authorized to discontinue all service for the transportation of passengers and property between Monterey and Big Sur and intermediate points, provided applicant shall file,

in triplicate, and make effective within a period of not to exceed twenty (20) days from the effective date of this order, on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and the public, cancellation of tariffs and time schedules now on file for such service.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Decisions Nos. 13102 and 20606 on Application No. 9738 be, and the same hereby are, revoked and annulled.

This order shall become effective upon signature thereof.
