O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, on August 9, 1934, applied for authority to transfer, sell, and convey to the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, a certain parcel of land situated between Spear Street and Main Street, north of Bryant Street, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said Department of Public Works proposes to install upon or over said property a portion of highway designated as "Road IV, City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge." Applicant and said Department of Public Works, on June 21, 1934, entered into an agreement covering the terms of said transfer or sale.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to transfer, sell,

and convey to the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, in accordance with the terms of an agreement dated June 21, 1934, a certified copy of which is attached to and made a part of the application and marked Exhibit "A" that certain parcel of land described therein and as shown by the map attached to and made a part of said agreement, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the property transfer and of the compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a determination of the value of the property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
- (3) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
