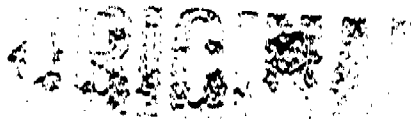


Decision No. 27292



BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of
PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
and EARL B. HOWARD for an order
of the Railroad Commission of the
State of California, authorizing
applicants to enter into a written
agreement in words and figures as
written in the form therefor which
is annexed hereto.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Earl B. Howard of El Dorado County, California, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a written agreement substantially in accordance with the words and figures as written in the form therefor marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein and entered into by and between the above mentioned parties, said agreement to be effective only for the period commencing July 1, 1934, and ending October 31, 1934, and providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to said Earl B. Howard from Pacific Gas and Electric Company's aqueduct in El Dorado County, known as Summerfield canal, on an accommodation basis to meet an emergency in connection with certain ranch activities, such quantity of water not exceeding a flow of one-quarter miner's inch⁽¹⁾ as shall be required by said Earl B. Howard for the aforementioned purposes, at the rate of fifteen (15) cents per miner's inch day,

1. A miner's inch for the purpose of this agreement shall mean 1.5 cubic feet of water per minute.

and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Earl B. Howard be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of water to said Earl B. Howard from Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Summerfield canal in El Dorado County under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
