O P I N I O N

In this application the Commission is asked to make an order cancelling Air Ferries, Ltd. Local Passenger Tariff No. 3, C.R.C. No. 3, and Local Express Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2, filed March 11, 1931. These tariffs provide rates and fares for the transportation of express and passengers between San Francisco Pier No. 3 and San Francisco Bay Airdrome, Alameda. Their cancellation is sought for the reason that the service performed thereunder has proved unprofitable and has been discontinued.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Air Ferries, Ltd., having made application for an order cancelling its Local Passenger Tariff No. 3, C.R.C. No. 3, and its Local Express Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2, and it being the opinion of the Commission that the application should be granted,
