O P I N I O N

By order dated July 10, 1934, in the above entitled proceeding, the Commission suspended until September 11, 1934, Supplement No. 1 to San Diego Forwarding Company's Local Freight Tariff No. 5, C.R.C. No. 5, naming a reduced rating on automobile parts. This schedule was suspended upon protests from competing common carriers alleging that if permitted to become effective it would be detrimental to their interests.

Thereafter respondent informed the Commission that it desired to cancel the suspended schedule and in lieu thereof publish a specific commodity rate of the volume of that maintained by protestants. Permission to do so was granted by the Commission¹ and the suspended schedule has been cancelled. The cause for suspension has thus been removed and our order of July 10, 1934, should be vacated and this proceeding discontinued.

O R D E R

Upon consideration of all the facts of record and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that our order of July 10, 1934, in the above entitled proceeding suspending Supplement No. 1 to San
