SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER AND ORDER DENYING REHEARING

W. J. and C. J. Fortier having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision 26876, careful consideration having been given to the allegations thereof, and after review of the record herein, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision 26876 is hereby amended and modified to read as follows:

## ORDER

venience and necessity or prior right authorizing such operation.

Based upon the finding herein and the opinion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that W. J. Fortier and C. J. Fortier, co-partners, under the fictitious name of Fortier Transportation Company, and each of them, shall cease and desist directly or indirectly or by any subterfuge or device from continuing such operation, unless and until they shall have obtained a certificate of public convenience and necessity therefor."

mission shall cause a certified copy of this decision to be personally served upon W. J. Fortier and C. J. Fortier; and that he cause certified copies to be mailed to the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco, the District Attorneys of Alameda, San Mateo, Contra Costa, Fresno, Tulare, and Kings Counties, and to the Department of Public Works Division of Highways, Sacramento.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the complaint is hereby dismissed as to G. L. Fortier and C. E. Fortier, co-partners under the name of Fortier Brothers.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the petition for rehearing filed by W. J. Fortier and C. J. Fortier is hereby denied.

The effective date of this decision shall be twenty (20) days after the date of service above mentioned.
