OPINION and ORDER

Roy E. Chappell, operating automotive service for the transportation of persons and property between Colfax and Michigan Bluff and intermediate points, has requested authority to discontinue said service and for an order revoking his operating right.

Applicant has lost the contract for carrying United States mail over the route, the revenue from which amounted to \$2892.00 in 1933. His gross revenue from passengers and property during the same year was \$460.83, or .0346 cents per mile for the 14,718 miles operated. It is obvious that public revenue will not support the service without loss. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Roy E. Chappell be, and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all service for the transportation of passengers and/or property between Colfax and Michigan Bluff and intermediate points, provided, applicant shall file, within twenty (20) days from date hereof, withdrawal and cancellation of his tariffs and time schedules covering such operation.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 23435, on Application No. 17204, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
