intermediate points, as originally granted by Decision No.5529,  
on Application No.3880, and

WHEREAS, Snyder and Hereford, a co-partnership, now  
advises the Commission, in writing, that no operations have  
been conducted under said operating right since August, 1931,  
and that no operations will be resumed, and requesting authority  
to "cancel its tariff"; and

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No.10773, on Appli-  
cation No.8087, and Decision No.5529 on Application No.3880, be  
and the same hereby are revoked and annulled, and that all  
tariffs and time schedules therefor be and the same hereby are  
canceled.
