## ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and L. I. Taylor having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a written agreement substantially in accordance with the words and figures as written in the form therefor marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein and entered into by and between the above-mentioned parties, said agreement to be effective only for the period commencing July 1, 1934, and ending October 31, 1934, and providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to said L. I. Taylor, on an accommodation basis to meet an emergency in connection with certain ranching activities in El Dorado County, of surplus water from said Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Summerfield canal not exceeding a flow of one-half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  miner's inch<sup>(1)</sup> of water to

1. A miner's inch for the purpose of this agreement shall mean 1.5 cubic feet of water per minute.

be paid for at the rate of fifteen cents (15c) per miner's inch day(2), and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and L. I. Taylor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of surplus water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
