## ORDER MODIFYING CRDER

Applicant seeks by the instant supplemental petition rearrangement of truck freight service between Fresno,
Stratford and Lemoore and Kettleman Hills, in order to maintain service to the unincorporated town of Avenal. The shifting of petroleum production in this field requires, from time to time, shifts in the method serving the active points. Avenal is now an active point for the delivery of freight, due to the construction of adequate roads. No other carrier serves the field from the three points of origin. Southern Pacific Company and Railway Express Agency, Inc. which serve Fresno, Stratford and Lemoore, points of origin, have waived objection to the request of applicant.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is unnecessary. The modification requested will be made.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decisions Nos.21495 and 21684 herein be and the same are hereby modified and amended by authorizing applicant, George Harm, to serve the town of Avenal either via the so-called "Sky Line" road between Kettleman City and Avenal, or via the so-called "Taft Road" between Coalinga and Avenal, and five (5) miles on either side of said highways, subject to the following conditions:

l. Applicant shall, within fifteen (15) days from date hereof, file his written acceptance of the modification herein authorized, accepting same as an extension and enlargement of the rights granted by Decisions Nos.21495 and 21684 herein, and not as a new or separate right, and limited to property originating at or destined to Lemoore, Stratford and/or Fresno.

2. Applicant shall file, in triplicate, and make effective within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days after the effective date of this order, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public a tariff or tariffs constructed in accordance with the requirements of the Commission's General Orders and containing rates to Avenal which shall be of the same volume as the rates concurrently maintained by applicant between Fresno, Stratford and Lemoore and Kettleman City.
