OPINION and ORDER

3-11-62

Applicant herein seeks authority to reroute its service between Los Gatos and Felton Road on its Santa Cruz division, via the new Santa Cruz mountain road through Vine Hill and to abandon its operations via Glenwood; also to strike from its tariffs and time tables the intermediate points of Glenwood, Vinehill Road and Sand Hill, and to substitute Vinehill as a new point in lieu of Vinehill Road. The alteration results from the improvement of the highway between Los Gatos and Santa Cruz and the practical abandonment of traffic over the old road over the Santa Cruz mountains. The new road possesses easy gradients and but few curves, and represents a saving of two miles. The road has a minimum width of 46 feet as against many narrow stretches on the old road.

This is a matter in which a public hearing appears unnecessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to reroute its service between the junction of Felton Road and Woodwardia over the new road through Vinehill, and to abandon its routing via Glenwood, Sand Hill and Vinehill Road; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER AUTHORIZED to eliminate the fare points of Glenwood, Sand Hill and Vinehill Road and to create a new point of Vinehill, and to file tariffs and time tables covering the alterations herein authorized and consistent with its rate structure and operating time.
