## ORDER

In this application the Central California Traction Company requests authority to sell and the Stockton Electric Railway Company authority to buy certain trackage in the City of Stockton.

The section of track involved is a double track street railway line with electrical overhead construction and trolley poles therefor, located on Weber Avenue between a point 65 feet east of the easterly property line of EL Dorado Street extended, and the westerly property line of Sacramento Street extended, the approximate length being .634 miles.

It appears that this track was at one time used jointly by both companies, each applicant owning one-half, but with the abandonment of interurb n passenger service by the Traction Company and the establishment of the freight terminal east of Wilson Way, use of this track by the Traction Company was no longer required.

The City of Stockton, through its City Attorney, has stated that At has no objection to the proposed sale and it

appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary

IT IS HEREBY CRDERED that Central California Traction
Company is hereby authorized to sell and Stockton Electric
Railway Company authorized to buy the above described section
of street railway track in Weber Avenue in the City of Stockton,
in accordance with the terms of the tentative agreement attached
to the application and marked Exhibit "A". Within thirty (30)
days from the completion of said sale, applicant shall file
with the Commission a certified copy of the agreement as executed.
