## CRDER GRANTING REROUTING

Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. requests authority to reroute its passenger, baggage and express service between Sacramento and Auburn by abandoning the old state highway route between a point north of Loomis and a point south of West Newcastle, and to use the new state highway recently completed between said points. The new route avoids steep grades and curves incident to the old one and permits faster and safer operation. The only other effect of the change will be to place applicant's station at Penryn one quarter of a mile east of its present location. No change in tariffs or time schedules is proposed.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. be and it hereby is authorized to abandon its route between Loomis and West Newcastle and to adopt the new state highway between said points for the operation of its passenger, baggage and express service, as authorized by Decision No. 23244, on Application No.16989, and Decision No.24745, on Application No.18112, and to the extent only as heretofore stated said decisions are hereby modified.
