ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

F. A. Minaker, operating certificated automotive service for the transportation of persons and property between Porterville and California Hot Springs has requested authority to abandon such service and, also, requests the revocation of his certificate therefor. Applicant alleges that the revenue from such service now does not exceed \$20.75 per month. Prior to July, 1934, applicant had the contract for transportation of United States mail. His annual report for 1933 shows a total revenue of \$2279.89, of which \$1794.50 was for transporting mail, the remainder \$485.39 being from public business.

Applicant has also requested authority (Application No.19644), to abandon service between Ducor and California Hot Springs. He is evidently confused because Decision No.25807, dated April 4, 1933, authorized abandonment of his route via Ducor, Fountain Springs, Zaluds, Rogers and Slinkards and substituted a route via Foothill boulevard without intermediates. The granting of Application No.19643 will be full authority for the remaining operation. Application No.19644, therefore, will be dismissed.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary.
The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that F. A. Minaker be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all service between Porterville and California Hot Springs, provided, applicant shall post notice of such discontinuance at least five (5) days before the effective date thereof and shall file, within ten (10) days after such discontinuance withdrawal and cancellation of his tariffs and time tables therefor.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decisions Nos. 7847 and 25807, on Application No. 4518, be and the same hereby are revoked and annulled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Application No. 19644 be and the same hereby is dismissed.
