## CRDER OF REVOCATION

L. B. C'Rourke, operating certificated automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Blairsden and Johnsville, has requested authority to abandon such sergice and, also, requests revocation of his certificate therefor. During 1933 applicant received no passengers nor freight, his sole revenue being from the transportation of United States mail. This mail revenue, amounting to \$1721.40 ceased July 1, 1934, when applicant's contract expired.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary.

The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that L. B. O'Rourke, operating passenger and property transportation service as a common carrier be tween Blairsden and Johnsville, be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all such service, providing applicant shall post notice of such discontinuance at his terminals at least five (5) days before the effective date of such discontinuance and shall file with the Commission within ten (10) days after such discontinuance withdrawal and cancellation of his tariffs and time schedules therefor.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No.20116, on Application No.14907, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
