ORDER DENYING REHEARING

The above entitled matter came on for further hearing and oral argument upon petition of defendant herein for a rehearing, and petition of complainant for a modification of Decision No. 27299 issued August 27, 1934.

During the pendency of these petitions, the effective date of said decision was extended to terminate contemporaneously with the further decision herein.

Argument on the petition was heard at San Francisco October 15, 1934, and the matter duly submitted. After careful consideration of the matters presented, it is my conclusion that neither complainant nor defendant has shown good cause why the decision as originally issued should be set aside or modified

and I therefore recommend the following form of order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petition for rehearing herein filed by defendant, and petition for modification as filed by complainant, and each of them, be and the same are hereby denied; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order of the Commission herein under date of October 8, 1934, extending the effective date of Decision No. 27299 during the pendency of said petitions be and the same is hereby rescinded.
