OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

Fred Dolley, operating automotive passenger and property service between Truckee and Sierraville, has requested authority to discontinue such service and for an order revoking the certificate therefor. Applicant's operations in 1933, as shown by his annual report, showed revenues of \$2473.11 (including \$2008.38 from transporting U. S. Mail), and expenses of \$2518.95, resulting in \$45.84 loss. Applicant's mail contract expired in July and the revenues from public service, he asserts, will not pay the cost of operation.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is unnecessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Fred Dolley be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all operation between Truckee and Sierraville for the transportation of passengers and property provided, applicant shall file immediately withdrawal and cancellation of his tariffs and time schedules covering such service; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No.23152, dated December 10, 1930, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
