FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND OFDER

By its Decision No. 26787, dated February 8, 1934, the Commission, under the above entitled matter, authorized the applicant, San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation, to make certain temporary and experimental rates effective for and at the times specified in the application, and to adjust, based on costs incurred by applicant, the charges made by it to Midland Counties Public Service Corporation to cover increased demands and energy requirements experienced during the period in which the latter utility employed similar rates, said adjustments to be submitted to the Commission from time to time for approval.

Applicant has now submitted to the Commission an adjusted billing for service rendered to Midland Counties Public Service Corporation for the months of April, May and June, 1934. The adjustment, under the method used by applicant, results in a credit to Midland Counties Public Service Corporation in the amount of \$25,132.50.

The Commission being of the opinion that this request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the aforesaid adjusted billing

of San Josquin Light and Power Corporation to Midland Counties
Public Service Corporation for the months of April May and June,
1934, be, and it is hereby approved.

This authorization is limited to the specific request herein and in no way is to be considered as binding on the Commission in future rate proceedings nor as an approval of the method used in determining intercompany energy charges.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
