FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Santa Barbara Telephone Company may issue at not less than par the \$100,000. of common stock authorized by Decision No. 23199, dated December 19, 1930, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including December 31, 1935, provided that applicant deposit all the proceeds received from the sale of said stock in a special bank account and withdraw said proceeds only for such purposes as may hereafter be permitted by the Commission in supplemental order or orders.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 23199, dated December 19, 1930, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Fourth Supplemental Order.
