ORIGINAL

A.C. MacFarlane, operating a public utility water system supplying a small number of consumers with water for domestic purposes in Crescent Bay Terraces, a subdivision on the shores of Clear Lake, Lake County, California, having applied for authority to discontinue further public utility business, an investigation having disclosed the fact that all of the consumers heretofore and now being served by this system desire and are willing to form a mutual water company to supply their respective homes, and it therefore appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, now, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A.C. MacFarlane be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all further public utility water service to his consumers in Crescent Bay Terraces, Lake County, California, on the thirtieth day of November, 1934, and thereafter said A.C. MacFarlane shall stand relieved of all further public utility obligations and liabilities in connection with said water system, subject, however, to the following terms and conditions:

1. On or before twenty (20) days from and after the date of this Order, A.C. MacFarlane shall notify in writing each of his consumers that he intends to discontinue further public utility service on the thirtieth day of November, 1934.
2. Within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, A.C. MacFarlane shall file with this Commission an affidavit indicating the date and the manner on and by which he has notified his consumers as required in Paragraph 1 above.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
