In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to (a) abandon the non-agency station of Terese, in the County of Kern, State of California, and (b) to abandon and remove the side track approximately 3006 feet in length, located at said station.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on October 15, 1934, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Terese, in Kern County, and to remove a side track approximately 3,006 feet in length, located at said station.

Applicant states that this facility has not been used for the receipt or delivery of freight for more than two (2) years and that the continued maintenance of a non-agency is not necessary for the applicant. nor for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified in writing that it does not object to the granting of this application. It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREEY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Terese, in Kern County, to eliminate said nonagency name from its station records, to cancel in con-

formity with the rules of this Commission all rates, tariffs and time schedules applying at said station, and to remove a side track approximately 3,006 feet in length located at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
