ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

In this proceeding respondent Pacific Package Distributors was ordered to appear before the Commission and show cause, if any it had, why its Local Express Tariff No. 1, C.R.C. No. 1, should not be cancelled. Although respondent was duly notified of the time and place of hearing it failed to appear. Thereafter it filed an informal application with the Commission for authority to cancel its tariff, alleging that the service it covered had been discontinued.
