ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

Joaquin Lopez, operating passenger and express service by automobile between Nevada City and Washington and intermediate points, has requested the Commission, to authorize him to discontinue service and also for the revocation of his operating right. Applicant has conducted the service since 1927, during all of which time he transported U. S. mail. The mail contract has terminated and his operation is now dependent upon public support. During 1933 his receipts from the transportation of mail were \$2400.00 and from all other public service \$182.15. During the same period his expense of operation was \$2029.50. Obviously, the operation cannot be conducted on a apparent income of \$15.00 a month.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary.

The request of the applicant will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Joaquin Lopez, operating automotive service for the transportation of passengers and express between Nevada City and Washington and intermediate points be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all service between said points, and all his tariffs and time tables therefore are ordered canceled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No.18004,
dated February 14, 1927, on Application No.13525, be and the
same hereby is revoked and annulled.
