Frank Chambers and Swen Mortensen having made application to this Commission for authority to transfer their interests in the Brighton Beach Water System used to supply consumers with water for domestic purposes at Brighton Beach, San Mateo County, to Salada Beach Public Utility District, a public utility district organized under the provisions of the Statutes of California 1921, Chapter 560, as amended, which District joins in said application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted, now, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Frank Chambers and Swen Mortensen be and they are hereby authorized to sell and transfer to Salada Beach Public Utility District such interests as applicants herein may own in that certain water system and the properties appurtenant thereto used for supplying water for domestic purposes in Brighton Beach in the County of San Mateo as such water system and properties appurtenant thereto are more particularly set forth and described in the application herein and which is made a part hereof by reference, subject to the following condition:

The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the thirty-first day of December, 1934, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Frank Chambers and Swen Mortensen and/or Salada Beach Public Utility District within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

The authority granted herein shall become effective on the date hereof.
