## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

The Commission on the 14th day of March, 1932, issued its Decision No. 24577 declaring defendants Frank Chambers, Swen Mortensen and Freda M. Freyer to be operating a public utility water system at Brighton Beach in the County of San Mateo and that said public utility service had been unlawfully discontinued without authority from this Commission. Said defendants were directed to resume water service to their consumers within thirty days from the date of said Order; however, this date was extended to the 31st day of December, 1934, for the purpose of permitting negotiations for the sale of said public utility water system to Salads Beach Public Utility District. By Decision No. 27539 in Application No. 19652, dated November 19, 1934, this Commission has authorized Frank Chambers and Swen Mortensen to sell and transfer to said District such

interests as they may own in sold system. The above District has been for some time last past and is now supplying all consumers heretofore served by the former public utility and it is therefore evident that the order directing resumption of service should be set aside.

## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that so much of the Order in said Decision No. 24577 as requires Frank Chambers and Swen Mortensen and Freda M. Freyer to resume service to those consumers residing in the area heretofore served by the water system owned and/or operated or controlled by them in the vicinity of Brighton Beach in San Mateo County and directs said parties to file with this Commission the schedule of rates charged for water service, together with rules and regulations governing the relations with their consumers be and the same is hereby vacated and set aside.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
