OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants seek an order authorizing the transfer by Gottlieb Eckdahl and E. B. Eckdahl, copartners, doing business under the firm name and style of G. Eckdahl & Son Warehouse Company, to A. Meyers, an individual, of the operating rights and equipment used in warehouse operation at Los Angeles by G. Eckdahl & Son Warehouse Company. The operative right was created by this Commission in Decision No. 22667 of March 31, 1930, in Application 16251. The transfer is to be in accordance with a Bill of Sale and Agreement, a copy of which is attached to the application. The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is \$750.00 and the assumption by the purchaser of all accounts payable of the warehouse business as of August 31, 1934.

A. Meyers will continue to operate the warehouse as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown in Warehouse Tariff No. 6, C.R.C. No. 6, filed in name of G. Eckdahl & Son Warehouse Company. The proposed transfer will not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a formal hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
2. Gottlieb Eckdahl and E. B. Eckdahl, copartners, and A. Meyers, an individual, shall within twenty (20) days after the effective date of the order, join in supplement to tariff on file with the Railroad Commission in name of G. Eckdahl & Son Warehouse Company, applicants Gottlieb Eckdahl and E. B. Eckdahl on the one hand withdrawing and applicant A. Meyers on the other hand accepting and adopting as his own such tariff and all effective supplements thereto.
3. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be conveyed may not be sold, leased, transferred nor assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, assignment or discontinuance has first been secured.

The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
