ORDER AMENDING ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the fourth paragraph of our order of December 22, 1934, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the operation of said Item 33-a of Supplement No. 13 to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's Tariff 14215-C, C.R.C. No. 639, in so far as it purports to provide a reduced rating for the transportation of compressed gases and empty cylinders between Los Angeles on the one hand and points east of San Bernardino to and including Daggett on the other, be and it is hereby suspended and the use thereof deferred until April 22, 1935, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, and no change shall be made in said item during the period of suspension or any extension thereof unless ordered by special permission of the Commission."

This order shall be effective on the date hereof.
