FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant, on December 11, 1934, filed its Fifth Supplemental Application No. 19305 asking that it be authorized to extend to and including June 29, 1935, the weekly pass form of transportation, as authorized in Decisions Nos. 27002 and 27175. Applicant's Local Passenger Tariff No. 16, C.R.C. No. 24, Page 3, filed with the Commission, designates said weekly pass form of fare as a permanent fare, which necessitates authority for cancellation should such cancellation be desired in the future. It appears that said Fifth Supplemental Application should be dismissed, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Fifth Supplemental Application No. 19305 be dismissed without prejudice.
