ORDER APPROVING WHARF FRANCHISE

Applicant by verified petition, asks this Commission to approve an ordinance of the City of Richmond, County of Contra Costa, State of California, granting to applicant a renewal of permission to maintain an existing wharf at said City extending into San Francisco Bay, and permission to construct and maintain an addition to said wharf, which is to be used by applicant solely for its own private commercial purposes as an adjunct to its refinery at Richmond.

Approval of this Commission to the grant of such franchise is required by Political Code, Section 2906. It appearing that such approval should be given, and that public hearing is not required, IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby accorded for the maintenance of a wharf and construction and maintenance of an addition thereto by Standard Oil Company of California.
