In the Matter of the Application of James A. Furnas d/b/a Independent Bus Line for authority to discontinue operation of an automobile service as a common carrier between Riverside and University of California Experimental Station.

BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION

James A. Furnas, operating automotive passenger service between Riverside and the University of California Experimental Station under the name and style of Independent Bus Line has requested authority to discontinue such service and for an order revoking the certificate therefor. Applicant's operations in 1933, as shown by his annual report, showed revenues of \$459.90 and expenses of \$548.05 resulting in an \$88.15 loss. Applicant now alleges that gross income will not exceed \$40 per month and this amount does not permit profitable operation.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that James A. Furnas, operating under the name and style of Independent Bus Line, be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all operations between Riverside and the University of California Experimental Station for the transportation of passengers and all his tariffs and time

schedules therefor are ordered cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 23407 dated February 16, 1931 on Application No. 17181 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
