In the Matter of the Suspension by the Commission on its own motion of reduced rates filed by Pacific Freight Tariff Bureau, F. W. Gomph, Agent, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company for the transportation of aluminum (alumina) salts from Nichols, Stege and other points in the San Francisco Bay district to Los Angeles, Long Beach, Los Angeles Harbor and other points in Southern California.

ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

The Commission suspended until February 15, 1935, Items 620-A and 690-A of Supplement 4 to Pacific Freight Tariff Bureau Tariff 30-M, C.R.C. 552 of F. W. Gomph, Agent; Item 710-A of Supplement 80 to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company Tariff 12375-N, C.R.C. 667; and Item 500-D Fourth Revised Page 81, Southern Pacific Company Tariff 730-D, C.R.C. 3353, naming reduced rates for the transportation of aluminum (alumina) salts from Nichols, Stege and other points in the San Francisco Bay district to Los Angeles, Long Beach, Los Angeles Harbor and other points in Southern California. The schedules were suspended upon protests from competing common carriers by water who alleged that the rates contained therein were unduly low and detrimental to their interests.

The matter was set for public hearing at San Francisco. Before the proceeding was heard, however, protestants requested that it be

discontinued. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that our orders of August 17, 1934, and December 10, 1934, in the above entitled proceeding, suspending Items 680-A and 690-A of Supplement 4 to Pacific Freight Tariff Bureau Tariff 30-M, C.R.C. 552, F. W. Gomph, Agent; Item 710-A of Supplement 20 to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company Tariff 12375-N, C.R.C. 667; and Item 500-D, Fourth Revised Page 31 of Southern Pacific Company Tariff 730-D, C.R.C. 3353, naming reduced rates on aluminum (alumina) salts, be and they are hereby vacated and set aside.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this proceeding be and it is hereby discontinued.
