TWELFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, in Decision No. 9412 (20, C.R.C.425) in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided, with reference to the rates therein established, that upon approval of the Railroad Commission Schedule No. 3 should be subject to decrease on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet for each decrease of ten (10) cents in the cost of oil below the price of \$1.65 per barrel at Sen Diego, and

Whereas, San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that on January 1, 1935, the price of oil at San Diego was increased fifteen (15) cents per barrel to minetyfive (95) cents, this being seventy (70) cents below the base price upon which Schedule No. 3 was established in Decision No. 9412.

IT IS HEREBY OPDERED that San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric Company be and it is hereby authorized to increase its present rate designated as Schedule No. 3, effective for all meter readings taken on and after March 1, 1935, so that said schedule No. 3 shall be twenty-one (21) cents below the basic rate established in Decision No. 9412.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that San Diego Consolidated Cas and Electric Company if it elects to exercise the
authority herein granted, file with this Commission or or before
March 1, 1935, the revision of its Schedule No. 3 herein authorized.
