Kathryn B.H. McGeoghegan and John T. McGeoghegan, owners of the Opal Water Works serving water for domestic purposes in and in the territory surrounding the Opal Subdivision, Santa Cruz County, California, having made application to this Commission for authority to sell and transfer said water works to one Frank T. Blake, who joins in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted, now, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Kathryn B.H. McGeoghegan and John T. McGeoghegan, her husband, be and they are hereby authorized to sell and transfer to Frank T. Blake that certain water system known as the Opal Water Works and the properties appurtenant thereto used for supplying water for domestic purposes to residents in and in the territory surrounding the Opal Subdivision, Santa Cruz County, California, as described in the certified copies of deed and bill of sale marked Exhibits "A" and "B", respectively, at-

tached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference,  
subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of March, 1935, and a certified copy of the final instrument or instruments of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Kathryn H.B. McGeoghegan and John T. McGeoghegan and/or Frank T. Blake within thirty (30) days from the date on which said instrument or instruments are executed.
2. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any other purpose than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority granted herein shall become effective on the date hereof.
