BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on January 26, 1935, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Hasset, in the County of Kings.

Applicant states that no freight or passenger business has been transacted at this station for more than thirty-four (34) months and that the continued maintenance of these facilities is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appears that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Hasset, in the County of Kings, State of California, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authorization herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
